## WATER OPERATOR'S REPORT:

Ted LaPine reports both the plant and creek in excellent condition with no too much turbidity. It hasn't been necessary to produce daily.

The leak detector was on site yesterday and suspected leaks near 121<sup>st</sup> streeet were not found. It was noted that the water coming out of the ground could be a spring.

Ted has no idea of usage; the tank is holding well. There is no way to gauge usage vs production. Ted will bring production numbers next month.

There are no disconnects nor requests for new service. 11408 NE Coos has asked for a locate.

ODOT is to be billed 3 months at the Commercial rate for usage of the hydrant during construction.

The Finesterre sign is missing and ODOT claims no responsibility.
